## **BASKETBALL REGISTRATION/PAYMENT FORM – SEMESTER 1 2022**

Dear Parents/Guardians

St Brigid's College participates in the Kalamunda and Districts Basketball Association (KDBA) Junior Competition at Ray Owen Sports Centre in Lesmurdie as part of our extra-curricular programme. If your daughter is interested in participating in this competition a completed registration form and player fee of \$260 (includes, game fees, umpire fees, uniform and awards) is required. If you have an existing uniform the fee is \$200. Teams will be registered for the competition only where there are suitable numbers to make a team. There is one slight change from previous years, Players (students) must register as a Basketball WA member with a new login and pay the \$36.75 one off fee. All other fees are included in the amount specified above.

The KDBA Junior Team competition runs each Monday evening during Semester One. This year's competition will run from 14<sup>th</sup> February through until 27<sup>th</sup> June (inclusive of finals, break over school holidays). Fixture details will be available at [www.kalamundabasketball.com.au](http://www.kalamundabasketball.com.au) during the competition.

Boarding students participating in this competition will be transported to and from the venue.

Please note: At this stage Kalamunda Basketball are unable to give you a definite answer as to what the future holds. Currently community sport is exempt from the double tax requirement, however we have to assume that this could potentially change in future. Some local councils are moving to very strict double tax policies (age 16+) for their venues as of January 31<sup>st</sup>. This is something students and parents need to be aware of as, this could result in any unvaccinated player or spectator being denied access to play or enter the stadium. If this occurs refunds may not be available once a student is registered with KDBA.
