**Scholarships for entry into Years 7 and 10, 2023
Saturday, 26th March 2022**

It gives me great pleasure to advise that the College will be offering Scholarships for entry into Years 7 and 10 in 2023.

As you may be aware, on the 18th February, the WA Government announced further public health and social measures to come into effect at 6.00a.m. on Monday, 21st February. This includes the requirement for masks to be worn indoors, unless exempt. We ask, therefore, that **all students** sitting our examinations, **wear a mask**, or provide proof of an exemption.

Please be aware, that candidates, accompanying adults, or an immediate family member experiencing compatible symptoms with COVID-19, are asked **not** to enter the College Campus and, as a consequence, their daughter will not be permitted to sit the examination. If a candidate presents with cold / flu-like symptoms, they will be isolated in an appropriate space and a parent or carer contacted and asked to collect their daughter as a matter of urgency.

In order for us to maintain appropriate physical distancing between candidates, examinations, this year, will be held in the College Gymnasium where this can be achieved. Parents / caregivers will not be permitted to enter the examination room.

Student attendance will be recorded from 8.15a.m. at the front of our main Reception area, with examinations expected to commence at 8.30a.m. Once registered, parents / caregivers are respectfully requested to leave the Campus. Please note that **masks are also required for any adults** on our College Campus accompanying the candidate to and from the examination.

Students may be collected at approximately 11.30a.m.

Your daughters are required to bring 2 blue or black ballpoint pens for the Written Expression section of the examination, 2HB or 2B pencils for the Multiple-Choice sections, an eraser and a water bottle.

Please note that registrations **close on Friday, 11th March 2022 and all documentation is to be returned by 4.00p.m.** on this date. **No late registrations will be accepted.**


